BY-LAW NO. 21-2000

### BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE CERTAIN TOWN STREETS DURING THE RIDGEWAY SUMMER FESTIVAL 2000 (T08)

---

**WHEREAS** Section 207(44) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 as amended provides that by-laws may be passed by council for closing to vehicular traffic on a temporary basis for such period as shall be specified in the by-law any highway or portion of a highway under the jurisdiction of the council for such social, recreational, community or athletic purpose, or combination of such purposes, as may be specified in the by-law, and

**WHEREAS** it is deemed desirable to temporarily close certain streets under the jurisdiction of the Town of Fort Erie during the Ridgeway Summer Festival 2000 sponsored by the Ridgeway Business Improvement Area Board of Management;


**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- (1) **THAT** Ridge Road between Wilson Street to Dominion Road and from Dominion Road to Farr Avenue be and they are hereby temporarily closed to vehicular traffic from 8:00 p.m. on Friday, July 7, 2000 to 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 9, 2000 and from the Waterfront Park at Terrace Lane to Crystal Beach Drive to Ridge Road from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Sunday July 9, 2000 for a "Ridge Road Race" which is in conjunction with Ridgeway Summer Festival 2000'.
- (2) **THAT** the Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie shall provide and keep in repair a reasonable temporary alternative route for traffic and for all property owners who cannot obtain access to their property by reason of such closing, where appropriate.
- (3) **THAT** there shall be erected at each end of each highway temporarily closed by this by-law and where an alternative route deviates therefrom, a barricade upon which an adequate warning device shall be exposed and in good working order continuously during the temporary road closures and there shall be erected at such points a detour sign indicating the alternative route and containing a notice that the highway is closed to vehicular traffic.

- (4) **THAT** every person who uses any part of any highway temporarily closed by this by-law does so at his own risk and the Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie shall not be liable for any damage sustained by a person using the highway or a portion thereof so temporarily closed to traffic.
