

## The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

BY-LAW NO. 33-2000

## BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO LOCAL ARCHITECTURAL CONSERVATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 209-97 (R01.07)

WHEREAS By-law No. 25-96 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1996 to establish the Fort Erie Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee (hereinafter referred to as "LACAC"), and

WHEREAS By-law No. 197-99 was passed by Council on December 13, 1999 to amend By-law No. 25-96 to expand the size of the committee and to alter its composition, and

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to fill the vacancies on the LACAC Committee, to waive the requirements of a Friends of the Railroad Association appointee and to amend By-law No. 209-97;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

(1) THAT the following persons be and they are hereby appointed to the LACAC Committee
for the period ending November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2000 or until such time as new appointments have been made by Council:

Joan Lyons-Felstead, Fort Erie Museum Constance M. Fraser, Bertie Historical Society Jim Garvin, citizen Lee Moore, citizen James R. Lovett, citizen Dennis Pepin, citizen Judith Saunders, citizen Joe Mrozek, Planning Department representative Councillor Haggerty; Councillor Anderson (Alternate)

(2) THAT the requirement for a Friends of the Railroad Association representative on LACAC as set out in By-law No. 25-96 as amended by By-law No. 197-99 be and it is hereby waived since a representative is not available for appointment.

- (3) THAT By-law No. 209-97 be and it is hereby amended under Section (1), 2.19 by deleting the appointees thereunder and inserting those appointees as set out under Section (1) herein.
- (4) THAT By-law Nos. 16-99 and 68-99 be and they are hereby repealed.
