BY-LAW NO. 51-2000

## BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE CERTAIN TOWN STREETS DURING THE ANNUAL RIDGEWAY VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTERS ASSOCIATION STREET DANCE

(T08)

WHEREAS Section 207(44) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, provides interalia that by-laws may be passed by council for closing to vehicular traffic on a temporary basis for such period as shall be specified in the by-law any highway or portion of a highway under the jurisdiction of the council for such social, recreational, community, athletic or cinematographic purposes, or combination of such purposes, as may be specified in the by-law, and

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to temporarily close a certain street under the jurisdiction of the Town of Fort Erie during the Annual Street Dance of the Ridgeway Volunteer Firefighters Association to be held June 24, 2000;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- (1) THAT Ridge Road from Dominion Road to Hazel Street be and it is hereby temporarily closed to vehicular traffic from 1:00 p.m. Saturday, June 24, 2000 to 1:30 a.m. Sunday, June 25, 2000, for the 63rd Annual Ridgeway Volunteer Fire Fighters Association Street Dance.
- (2) THAT the Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie shall provide and keep in repair a reasonable temporary alternative route for traffic and for all property owners who cannot obtain access to their property by reason of such closing, where appropriate.
- (3) THAT there shall be erected at each end of each highway temporarily closed by this by-law and where an alternative route deviates therefrom, a barricade upon which an adequate warning device shall be exposed and in good working order continuously during the temporary road closures and there shall be erected at such points a detour sign indicating the alternative route and containing a notice that the highway is closed to vehicular traffic.

(4) THAT every person who uses any part of any highway temporarily closed by this by-law does so at his own risk and The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie shall not be liable for any damage sustained by a person using the highway or a portion thereof so temporarily closed to traffic.
