BY-LAW NO. 111-2000

## BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW NO. 2000-89 RESPECTING TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC DURING THE FRIENDSHIP FESTIVAL (T08)

**WHEREAS** By-law No. 2000-89 as amended provides for the regulation of traffic and parking on the highways of the Town of Fort Erie, and

**WHEREAS** in order to provide for emergency vehicle access during Friendship Festival, it is deemed expedient to temporarily restrict parking on the highways identified hereunder for the times and dates stated;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

- (1) **THAT** By-law No. 2000-89 be and it is hereby amended under Schedule "C" and Schedule "R" by adding the following thereto in order to provide for emergency vehicle access during the Friendship Festival between June 28<sup>th</sup> – July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2000;
