BY-LAW NO. 111-2000

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW NO. 2000-89 RESPECTING TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC DURING THE FRIENDSHIP FESTIVAL (T08)

WHEREAS By-law No. 2000-89 as amended provides for the regulation of traffic and parking on the highways of the Town of Fort Erie, and

WHEREAS in order to provide for emergency vehicle access during Friendship Festival, it is deemed expedient to temporarily restrict parking on the highways identified hereunder for the times and dates stated;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

(1) THAT By-law No. 2000-89 be and it is hereby amended under Schedule "C" and Schedule "R" by adding the following thereto in order to provide for emergency vehicle access during the Friendship Festival between June 28th – July 4th, 2000;

- (2) THAT Albany Street be posted no parking and designated as one-way traffic westbound from Garrison Road to the intersection of Beatrice and King Streets subject to the Friendship Festival organization providing and ensuring that security at the intersection of Garrison Road and Albany Street and at the intersection of Beatrice and King Streets is present at all times during the one-way restriction in order to ensure compliance with the by-law.
- (3) **THAT** the Town of Fort Erie supply the appropriate signs to the Friendship Festival for the period June 28, 2000 to July 4, 2000, subject to the Friendship Festival being responsible for erecting and maintaining the signs pursuant to the Town's instructions.
