BY-LAW NO. 115-2000

### BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE USE OF VOTING AND VOTE-COUNTING EQUIPMENT AT ELECTIONS (C07.92.22)

---

**WHEREAS** Section 42(1)(a) of the *Municipal Elections Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.53 provides the council of a local municipality may pass by-laws authorizing the use of voting and vote-counting equipment such as voting machines, voting recorders or optical scanning vote tabulators, and

**WHEREAS** at the Council-in-Committee meeting of May 15, 2000 Report No. F-20-2000 was approved authorizing the use of voting and vote-counting equipment such as voting machines, voting recorders or optical scanning vote tabulators by electors in the Town of Fort Erie for municipal election purposes. Subject to the Town's solicitor's approval, the Clerk was authorized to enter into a rental agreement with Global Elections Systems Inc. for the rental of the Accu-Vote tabulating equipment, and

**WHEREAS** it is deemed desirable to authorize the use of such equipment for municipal election purposes;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the use of voting and vote-counting equipment such as voting machines, voting recorders or optical scanning vote tabulators be and they are hereby permitted to be used for municipal election purposes in the Town of Fort Erie.
