BY-LAW NO. 119-2000

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE CERTAIN TOWN STREETS DURING THE RIDGEWAY CENTRE FOR THE ARTS SUMMER FESTIVAL 2000 (T08)

WHEREAS Section 207(44) of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 as amended provides that by-laws may be passed by council for closing to vehicular traffic on a temporary basis for such period as shall be specified in the by-law any highway or portion of a highway under the jurisdiction of the council for such social, recreational, community or athletic purpose, or combination of such purposes, as may be specified in the by-law, and

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to temporarily close certain streets under the jurisdiction of the Town of Fort Erie during the Summer Festival 2000 sponsored by the Ridgeway Centre for the Arts;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

(1) THAT Hibbard Street between Ridge Road and the Friendship Trail Parking Lot Access be and it is hereby temporarily closed to vehicular traffic on the following dates and times for the Ridgeway Centre for the Arts "Summer Festival 2000":

- (2) **THAT** liability insurance in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 be provided, naming the Town as additional insured.
- (3) THAT the Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie shall provide and keep in repair a reasonable temporary alternative route for traffic and for all property owners who cannot obtain access to their property by reason of such closing, where appropriate.
- (4) THAT there shall be erected at each end of each highway temporarily closed by this by-law and where an alternative route deviates therefrom, a barricade upon which an adequate warning device shall be exposed and in good working order continuously during the temporary road closures and there shall be erected at such points a detour sign indicating the alternative route and containing a notice that the highway is closed to vehicular traffic.
- (5) **THAT** every person who uses any part of any highway temporarily closed by this by-law does so at his own risk and the Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie shall not be liable for any damage sustained by any person using the highway or a portion thereof so temporarily closed to traffic.
- (6) THAT every person who without lawful authority uses that portion of any highway so closed to traffic by this by-law or who removes or defaces any barricade, device, detour sign or notice placed thereon by lawful authority, is guilty of an offence and is also liable to The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie for any damage or injury occasioned by such wrongful use, removal or defacement and upon conviction thereof, shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting court a penalty not exceeding (exclusive of costs) the sum of \$5,000.00 for each offence and every such fine is recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
