

## The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

BY-LAW NO. 122-2000

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 96-2000 (TO SET THE 2000 TAX RATES AND TO LEVY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2000) AND TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 118-2000

WHEREAS By-law No. 96-2000 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May 2000 to set the 2000 tax rates and to levy taxes for the year 2000, and

WHEREAS pursuant to notice received that Regional Council amended its By-law No. 57-2000 (Setting Rates of Taxation for Regional Purposes) after some confusion over the calculation of Education Tax Rates for the Large Industrial and Industrial classes, By-Law No. 118-2000 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May, 2000 to amend By-law No. 96-2000 accordingly, and

WHEREAS the Minister of Finance by letter dated June 2, 2000 advised that a special reduction in the Industrial Tax Rates will not be permitted and therefore it is deemed necessary to amend Bylaw No. 96-2000 accordingly;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

(1) THAT By-law No. 118-2000 be and it is hereby repealed.
