BY-LAW NO. 128-2000

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BILL DISTRIBUTORS LICENCING AND REGULATION BY-LAW NO. 91-2000 (310201)

WHEREAS By-law No. 91-2000 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 25th day of April, 2000 to licence and regulate bill distributors in the Town of Fort Erie and to repeal By-law No. 182-90, and

WHEREAS due to the enforcement of this by-law, it has become apparent that the community newspaper should not be subject to the provisions of the by-law since homeowners are generally motivated to retrieve the community newspaper from their driveway, and

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to exclude newspapers from the definition of the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

- (1) THAT By-law No. 91-2000 be and it is hereby amended under Section 1 (a) and (b) by deleting the word "newspapers" therefrom.
- (2) THAT Section 1 be and it is hereby further amended by adding the following section thereto:
 - (c) "Newspaper" means a printed publication in sheet form, intended for general circulation, published regularly at intervals of not longer than a week, consisting in great part of news of current events of general interest and distributed to the public.
- (3) THAT By-law No. 91-2000 be and it is hereby further amended by adding the following section:
 - (9) THAT the provisions of this by-law shall not apply to newspapers.
