BY-LAW NO. 128-2000

---

### BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BILL DISTRIBUTORS LICENCING AND REGULATION BY-LAW NO. 91-2000 (310201)

---

**WHEREAS** By-law No. 91-2000 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2000 to licence and regulate bill distributors in the Town of Fort Erie and to repeal By-law No. 182-90, and

**WHEREAS** due to the enforcement of this by-law, it has become apparent that the community newspaper should not be subject to the provisions of the by-law since homeowners are generally motivated to retrieve the community newspaper from their driveway, and

**WHEREAS** it is deemed desirable to exclude newspapers from the definition of the by-law;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

- (1) **THAT** By-law No. 91-2000 be and it is hereby amended under Section 1 (a) and (b) by deleting the word "newspapers" therefrom.
- (2) **THAT** Section 1 be and it is hereby further amended by adding the following section thereto:
  - (c) **"Newspaper"** means a printed publication in sheet form, intended for general circulation, published regularly at intervals of not longer than a week, consisting in great part of news of current events of general interest and distributed to the public.
- (3) **THAT** By-law No. 91-2000 be and it is hereby further amended by adding the following section:
  - (9) **THAT** the provisions of this by-law shall not apply to newspapers.
