BY-LAW NO. 151-2000

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 35-2000 (TO REGULATE THE USE OF THE FRIENDSHIP TRAIL) – EQUESTRIAN USE (360502)

WHEREAS By-law No. 35-2000 being a by-law to regulate the use of the Friendship Trail was approved by Council at its Regular meeting held the 20th day of February, 2000, and

WHEREAS at the Regular meeting of Council held August 21, 2000 Resolution No. was approved authorizing that horses be allowed on the Friendship Trail from Gorham Road westerly to Holloway Bay Road, and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend By-law No. 35-2000 to allow horses on the Friendship Trail from Gorham Road westerly to Holloway Bay Road;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT Section (5) Part IV of By-law No. 35-2000 be and it is hereby amended by adding the words "save and except for the Phase III portion of the recreational trail from Gorham Road westerly to Holloway Bay Road after the completion of the design, funding and construction criteria are met and the Phase III section of the trail is designed in such a way that it does not impede the future development of the paved multi-use trail".
