BY-LAW NO. 203-2000

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 166-2000 (TO DEEM A CERTAIN REGISTERED PLAN OF SUBDIVISION NOT TO BE A REGISTERED PLAN OF SUBDIVISION FOR THE PURPOSES OF SECTION 50, SUBSECTION 3 OF THE PLANNING ACT R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13 INSOFAR AS IT ONLY APPLIES TO CERTAIN LANDS AS FOLLOWS:

Lots 3 & 40, Plan 88, NP 548)

WHEREAS By-law No. 166-2000 being a by-law to deem a certain registered plan of subdivision not to be a registered plan of subdivision for the purposes of Section 50, Subsection 3 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13 insofar as it only applies to certain lands as follows: Doris & Henk Post, east side of Ridgeway Road, south of Brewster Road, Lots 3 & 40, Plan 88, NP 548 was approved by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie at its Regular Council meeting held September 11, 2000, and

WHEREAS an application for the subject property was previously processed resulting with the registration of By-law No. 73-2000, and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to repeal By-law No. 166-2000;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:
