BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS BOARDS AND COMMITTEES OF THE TOWN OF FORT ERIE AND TO AMEND AND REPEAL VARIOUS BY-LAWS (120401)

WHEREAS Council Rules of Procedure By-law No. 200-85, as amended as well as certain other by-laws of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie, provide for the appointment of members of council and resident taxpayers to the various boards and committees of the Town of Fort Erie, and

WHEREAS the term of office for those persons appointed to the Town's various boards and committees by By-law No. 200-97, as amended and By-law No. 209-97, as amended expired on November 30, 2000, and

WHEREAS pursuant to Section C5 of By-law No. 200-85, as amended at the meeting of Council-Elect held November 27th, 2000 recommendations were made for the appointment of persons to the various boards and committees as well as certain amendments to the Procedural By-law to increase or decrease the composition of certain boards and committees as well as other affected by-laws, and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to appoint persons to the various boards and committees as well as to enact amendments to the Procedural By-law and other related by-laws in accordance with the recommendations of the Council-Elect;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Sections C5.2 (b) and (c) of By-law No. 200-85, as amended, be and they are hereby amended by deleting the words "resident taxpayers" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "residents, business owners/operators or taxpayers".
2. **THAT** Section C6. APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED TO BE MADE BY COUNCIL of By-law No. 200-85 as amended, be and it is hereby amended by deleting same in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof Schedule "A" annexed hereto to this by-law.
3. **THAT** the following persons be and they are hereby appointed to the boards and committees listed hereunder for the period ending November 30, 2003.

6. **THAT** Section 3(b) of By-law No. 61-99 (Bridgeburg Downtown Business Improvement Area), be and it is hereby amended by deleting the words “two of whom shall be members of the Council” and inserting in lieu thereof “one of whom shall be a member of Council”.
7. **THAT** Section 3(b) of By-law No. 63-99 (Crystal Beach Improvement Area), be and it is hereby amended by deleting the words “shall consist of five members appointed” and inserting in lieu thereof the words “shall consist of a maximum of seven members appointed”.
8. **THAT** Section 3(b) of By-law No. 62-99 (Ridgeway Business Improvement Area), be and it is hereby amended by deleting the words “shall consist of five members appointed” and inserting in lieu thereof the words “shall consist of a maximum of seven members appointed”.
9. **THAT** Section 2 of By-law No. 291-88 (Fort Erie Museum Board), be and it is hereby amended by deleting same and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

“That the Fort Erie Museum Board shall consist of nine members, four members of which shall be representatives of the Bertie Historical Society and four members of which shall be representatives of the Fort Erie Historical Railroad Museum Association and one member shall be a member of Council and all members shall be appointed by the Council of the Town of Fort Erie”

12. **THAT** Section 6.1.1 of By-law No. 183-98, (Property Standards) be and it is hereby amended by deleting the word “3” and inserting in lieu thereof the word “5” in the second line.

13. **THAT** Section 2 of By-law No. 132-96 (Street Lighting Policy), as amended by By-law No. 51-99, be and it is hereby amended by deleting the words "3 members of Council" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "one member of Council".
14. **THAT** By-law Nos. 200-97, 209-97, 12-98, 29-98, 66-98, 125-98, 144-98, 169-98, 213-98, 51-99, 71-99, 55-2000 and 143-2000, be and they are hereby repealed.

C6 APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED TO BE MADE BY COUNCIL

That the following boards and committees and compositions thereto be and they are hereby established for the term of Council:

- C6.1 FORT ERIE CEMETERY ADVISORY COMMITTEE** to be composed of six (6) citizen appointees and one (1) member of Council.
- C6.2 STEVENSVILLE MEMORIAL HALL BOARD** to be composed of six (6) citizen appointees and one (1) member of Council (with one alternate member of Council, if required).
- C6.3 FORT ERIE PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD** to be composed of nine (9) members; five (5) citizen appointees, two (2) members recommended by the District School Board of Niagara, one (1) member recommended by the Niagara Catholic District School Board and one (1) member of Council (with one (1) alternate member of Council, if required).
- C6.4 COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT** to be composed of seven (7) citizen appointees.
- C6.5 FORT ERIE MUSEUM BOARD** to be composed of eight (8) citizen Appointees and one (1) member of Council [four (4) to be recommended by the Bertie Historical Society and four (4) to be recommended by the Friends of the Railroad Museum].
- C6.7 NIAGARA PARKS COMMISSION (FORT ERIE REPRESENTATIVE)** being the Head of Council.
- C6.8 SENIOR CITIZENS ADVISORY AD HOC COMMITTEE** to be composed of the following:

Seniors Group with less than 100 members =	1 Committee Member
Seniors Group with more than 100 members =	2 Committee Members

presently including, but not limited to the following:

- .01 One (1) member of Council;
- .02 Two(2) Senior Citizen representatives appointed by the "Beachcombers" of Ridgeway;

- .03 Two(2) Senior Citizen representatives appointed by "Harmony Hill" of Fort Erie;
- .04 Two(2) Senior Citizen representatives appointed by the "Italo Canadian Seniors Club";
- .05 Two(2) Senior Citizen representatives appointed by the '96'ERS" of Fort Erie;
- .06 One(1) Senior Citizen representatives appointed by the "Stevensville District Seniors Association";
- .07 Two(2) representatives from Branch 71 Legion.
- .08 Two (2) representatives from Black Creek Leisure Homes Seniors Group

C6.9 MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE to be composed of four (4) citizen appointees, one (1) member of Council (Planning and Community Services) and Mayor as Ex-Officio.

C6.10 BOARD OF MANAGEMENT FOR THE BRIDGEBURG STATION DOWNTOWN BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA to be composed of seven (7) to eleven (11) members from the designated Business Improvement Area and one (1) member of Council.

C6.11 FORT ERIE S.P.C.A. to be composed of one (1) member of Council (with one (1) alternate member of Council, if required).

C6.12 PROPERTY STANDARDS COMMITTEE to be composed of five (5) citizen appointees.

C6.13 COURT OF REVISION to be composed of three (3) members of Council with two (2) alternate members of Council.

C6.14 BOARD OF MANAGEMENT FOR THE CRYSTAL BEACH IMPROVEMENT AREA to be composed of a maximum of six (6) members from the designated Improvement Area and one (1) member of Council.

C6.15 BOARD OF MANAGEMENT FOR THE RIDGEWAY BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA to be composed of a maximum of six (6) members from the designated Business Improvement Area and one (1) member of Council.

C6.16 A LOCAL ARCHITECTURAL CONSERVATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE (LACAC) to be composed of one (1) member of Council (with one (1) alternate member of Council, if required) four (4) citizen appointees, one (1) Museum Board or Staff member, one (1) member of the Friends of the Railroad Museum, one (1) member of Bertie Historical Society and one staff member from the Planning and Property Safety Department.

- C6.17 COMMUNITY GAMING DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION OF FORT ERIE** to be composed of seven (7) citizens, one (1) member of Council and one (1) Staff member.
- C6.18 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION** (municipal representation) to be composed of two (2) members of Council, one of whom shall be the Head of Council.
- C6.19 FORT ERIE NON-PROFIT HOUSING CORPORATION** (municipal representation) to be composed of one (1) member of Council (with one (1) alternate member of Council, if required).
- C6.20 NIAGARA PENINSULA CONSERVATION AUTHORITY** (municipal representation) to be composed of one (1) member of Council to be nominated to Regional Council.
